BACKGROUND

The Joint Conference is for the fourth time organized in this format. The main goal of this conference is to provide a multidisciplinary forum between researchers from industry and academia to discuss state-of-the-art topics in system theory, control and computing, and to present recent research results and prospects for development in this evolving area.

The ICSTCC conference emerged from the fusion of the three conferences which were separately organized by University of Craiova, Faculty of Automation, Computers and Electronics (SINTES - International Conference on System Theory and Control), "Gheorghe Asachi" Technical University of Iași, Faculty of Automatic Control and Computer Engineering (SACCS - International Symposium on Automatic Control and Computer Science), "Dunărea de Jos" University of Galați, Faculty of Control Systems, Computers, Electrical and Electronics Engineering (SIMSIS - International Symposium on Modelling, Simulation and Identification Systems). **As well as the previous editions, The 17th International Conference on System Theory, Control and Computing – ICSTCC 2013, is technically co-sponsored by IEEE Control Systems Society and the papers will be indexed in IEEE Xplore.**

ICSTCC 2013 will feature several kinds of presentations including invited and contributed papers, special sessions and poster sessions. The outcome of ICSTCC 2013 can be a better understanding of some leading research areas, as already System Theory, Control and Computing have demonstrated.

PAPERS SUBMISSION

Full papers should be submitted using the EasyChair online submission system. The papers will undergo a peer review process, coordinated by the International Program Committee. The corresponding author of each paper will be notified of the result by e-mail. All materials must be written in English. If the paper is accepted, at least one of the authors must attend the conference and present the paper.

All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. For publication at least one author must register at the conference and submit the paper in due time. The participants must prepare the full version of their paper following IEEE Conference Submission Standards. Maximum six pages A4 in double column format are allowed. Authors may upload longer manuscript up to a maximum of eight pages total. However, each page in excess of six will incur a charge of 50 Euros.

SPECIAL SESSIONS

Proposals for INVITED SESSIONS in the scope of the conference are welcome. People interested in organizing a SESSION should notify their intention to the conference secretariat at address given below (please see [CONTACTS](#)).

A proposal for INVITED SESSION should contain the title of the session, a list of five or six papers, together with an extended summary (2000 words) of each paper. Proposal should be sent by April 15th, 2013. Notification of acceptance will be communicated by June 30th, 2013, and the procedure will be similar to the regular papers.

The final camera ready manuscript and registration payment of at least one of the authors are due by July 15th, 2013.

CONFERENCE FEES

- Early registrations (before July 15th 2013) fee: 250 Euro (200 Euro for IEEE Members);
- Late registrations fee: 300 Euro (250 Euro for IEEE Members);
- Early student registration (before July 15th, 2013) fee: 150 Euro;
- Late student registration fee: 180 Euro.

PUBLICATION AND COPYRIGHT

Papers submitted for presentation should contain original research, not published or being considered for publication elsewhere. Authors of accepted papers are expected to attend the conference and present the paper. Selected papers will be invited to appear in: *Journal of Control Engineering and Applied Informatics (ISI Journal)*; *Annals of the University of Craiova*; *Bulletin of the Polytechnic Institute of Iași*; *Annals of "Dunărea de Jos", University of Galați*. As a part of the procedure, authors of accepted papers must send us a signed Copyright Form for each paper. Missing the document may lead to paper unpublishing.
