ISPA 2011 will be organized in Dubrovnik, Croatia, which is located on the Adriatic Sea coast in the extreme south of Dalmatia. George Bernard Shaw was enchanted by this beautiful city, about which he said "those who seek paradise on Earth should come to Dubrovnik and see Dubrovnik", as well as, famously, describing it as "the pearl of the Adriatic". Dubrovnik, with its amazing Old Town, became a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1979.

Author Information

Papers including title, author list and affiliations, figures, results, and references should not exceed six A4 pages. Detailed author instructions are available on the ISPA web site. All submissions will be subject to an international peer-review process. The symposium publications are abstract book and CD-ROM proceedings. Accepted papers will be available through IEEE Publications Center and in IEEE Xplore digital library. Authors of accepted papers are required to register and present the paper.
