Submission of Papers

We invite electronic submissions for MICCAI 2008 (LNCS style, double blind review) of up to 8-page papers for oral or poster presentation. Papers will be reviewed by members of the program review committee and assessed for quality and best means of presentation. Besides advances in methodology, we would also like to encourage submission of papers that demonstrate clinical relevance, clinical applications, and validation studies. Further information on paper submissions, including format, will be available on the conference website, from December 2007.

Proposals for Tutorials and Workshops

Tutorials will be held on September 6th or 10th, 2008 and will complement and enhance the scientific program of MICCAI 2008. The purpose of the tutorials is to provide educational material for training new professionals in the field including students, clinicians and new researchers. The website facility for submitting tutorial proposals will open in December 2007.

Workshops will be held on September 6th or 10th, 2008 and will provide opportunity for discussing technical and application issues in depth. The purpose of the workshops is to provide a comprehensive forum on topics which will not be fully explored during the main conference. The website facility for submitting workshop proposals will open in December 2007.
